Barren County Schools: Who They Are

Barren County is a rural school district recognized by the state as a growth district. Located in South Central Kentucky near Barren River Lake State Resort Park and Mammoth Cave National Park, it encompasses seven elementary schools, one middle school, a 9th grade transitional academy and one high school.

An Outdated Phone System: What Barren County Schools Needed

As its Iwatsu telephone systems reached end of life, the district began a search for a robust, cost-effective communications platform that would keep up with the area's projected growth and help cut monthly costs.

Gumm found the solution and the partners they were looking for, with the Mitel communications platform recommended by the district's new communications vendor, Gibson Teldata.
